

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
Why is writing challenging for students?


- conventions of written language differ from spoken language
- writing requires decision making, planning, analysis, etc.
- need background knowledge to write about a topic coherently
- imposes heavy cognitive load on novice and struggling writers



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Six Principles

- Students need explicit instruction in writing, beginning in the early elementary grades.
- Sentences are the building blocks of all good writing.
- When embedded in the content of the curriculum, writing instruction is a powerful teaching tool.
- The content of the curriculum drives the rigor of the writing activities.
- Grammar is best taught in the context of student writing.
- The two most important phases of the writing process are planning and revising.



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The Interplay of Writing with Knowledge

- strong relationship between writing & knowledge acquisition
- TWR strategies help build & deepen content knowledge
- writing reveals gaps in students' grasp of a topic
- TWR strategies serves as comprehension checks

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Why teach appositives?

- Written language structure
- Varies sentence structure
- Adds information & complexity
- Improves & checks reading comprehension
- Encourages careful reading
- Strategy for creating a topic sentence (T.S.)
 & a concluding sentence (C.S.)

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1. Identify Appositives

- Temperature, a physical quantity that expresses hot and cold, is measured with a thermometer.
- Weather, the state of the atmosphere at a given time and place, is driven by air pressure, temperature, and moisture.
- Seasons, <u>the four divisions of the year</u>, are marked by changes in weather, ecology and the amount of daylight.

a ballot which is cast anonymously

the upper house of Parliament

a system in which electors are required to vote

- 1. The Senate, the upper house of Parliament, equally represents each state.
- The secret ballot, a ballot which is cast anonymously, originated in Australia.

SPO Scaffolding Activities


- Distinguish T.S. from details
- Given T.S., generate details
- Given topic, write T.S.
- Given details, generate T.S.
- Identify T.S. & sequence details
- Given T.S., select appropriate details from a list
- Eliminate irrelevant detail(s)
- Given T.S. & details, generate C.S.
- Given a paragraph, convert to SPO
